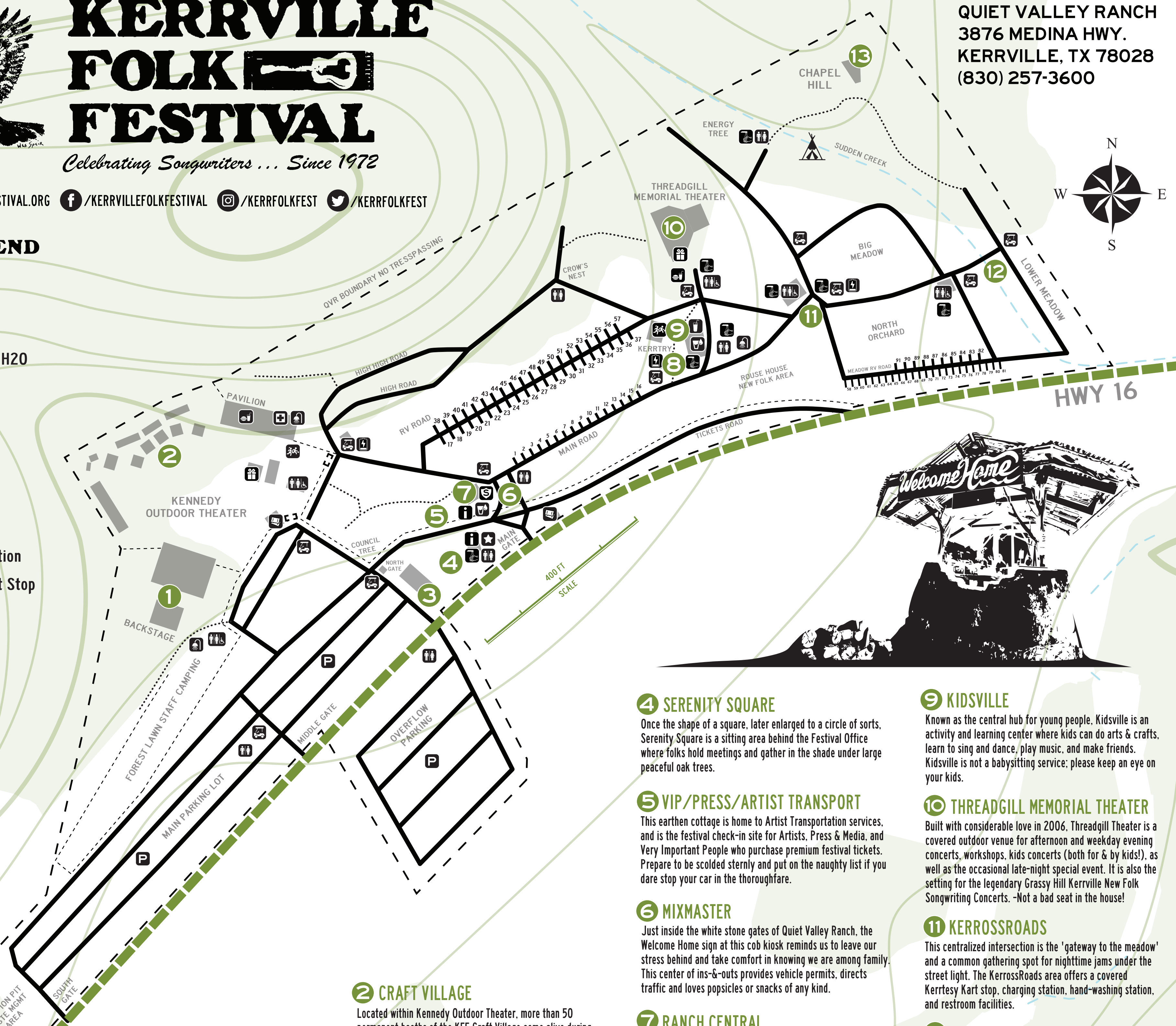
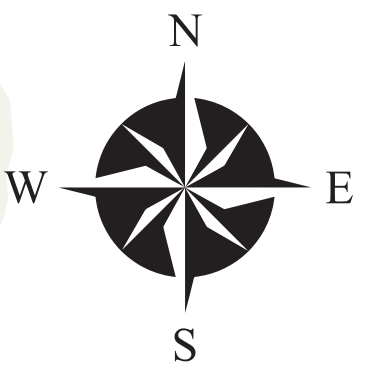

POINTS OF INTEREST

1 KENNEDY OUTDOOR THEATER

Founder Rod Kennedy chose this site for the Kerrville Folk Festival stage in 1974. Since the founding years, it has gone on to feature hundreds of legendary folk musicians and helped launch many a music career. Also a realm for weekday songwriting workshops, the evening concerts held here feature food and festivities, libations and dancing, all set to original folk music. Whether you bring a chair, blanket, or enjoy one of our house benches, its easy to relax and appreciate the heart and soul of each performance, while savoring the magic of KFF.

2 CRAFT VILLAGE

Located within Kennedy Outdoor Theater, more than 50 permanent booths of the KFF Craft Village come alive during evening concerts to offer spectacular hand-made crafts, unique clothing, fine art, musical instruments, jewelry, potions and massage. Other booths include the KFF Foundation Booth, where folks can enter the Guitar Raffle, bid in the Silent Auction, and join as a member of the KFF Foundation, to help steer the future of what many simply call "Kerrville".

3 STAFF CENTRAL

Now sharing a roof with the maintenance barn, Staff Central is THE hub for all-things-Volunteer-Staff. Beyond Volunteer check-ins, Staff Central offers a sitting area for folks to meet, as well as space for important announcements like crew meetings, special events & ride shares.

4 SERENITY SQUARE

Once the shape of a square, later enlarged to a circle of sorts, Serenity Square is a sitting area behind the Festival Office where folks hold meetings and gather in the shade under large peaceful oak trees.

5 VIP/PRESS/ARTIST TRANSPORT

This earthen cottage is home to Artist Transportation services, and is the festival check-in site for Artists, Press & Media, and Very Important People who purchase premium festival tickets. Prepare to be scolded sternly and put on the naughty list if you dare stop your car in the thoroughfare.

6 MIXMASTER

Just inside the white stone gates of Quiet Valley Ranch, the Welcome Home sign at this cob kiosk reminds us to leave our stress behind and take comfort in knowing we are among family. This center of ins-&-outs provides vehicle permits, directs traffic and loves popsicles or snacks of any kind.

7 RANCH CENTRAL

Also known as the Pumpkin Shack, Ranch Central serves as an information station, lost & found, as well as a 24-hr Security hub and pivot point for emergencies. Ranch Central also offers a small book exchange, ATM, information board, and serves as a center for mobility assistance.

8 KERRTRY STORE & KOURTYARD

Centrally located in the campground, the Kerrtry Store offers beer, sodas, coffee, ice, and is a good place to look for public announcements, ride shares, and special events. The Kerrtry Kourtyard is a stage and community hangout space, great for enjoying lunch, beer, a game of chess and spontaneous neighborhood jams.

9 KIDSVILLE

Known as the central hub for young people, Kidsville is an activity and learning center where kids can do arts & crafts, learn to sing and dance, play music, and make friends. Kidsville is not a babysitting service; please keep an eye on your kids.

10 THREADGILL MEMORIAL THEATER

Built with considerable love in 2006, Threadgill Theater is a covered outdoor venue for afternoon and weekday evening concerts, workshops, kids concerts (both for & by kids!), as well as the occasional late-night special event. It is also the setting for the legendary Grassy Hill Kerrville New Folk Songwriting Concerts. -Not a bad seat in the house!

11 KERROSSROADS

This centralized intersection is the 'gateway to the meadow' and a common gathering spot for nighttime jams under the street light. The KerrossRoads area offers a covered Kerrtesy Kart stop, charging station, hand-washing station, and restroom facilities.

12 VIBE TRIBE CAMP

Keeping the festivities vivacious in the meadow, Vibe Tribe Crew's base camp is a creative place where you might find inspiration or get in on the fun! Keep an eye out for Vibe Tribe and their artwork all around the ranch. 'Art is how we decorate space. Music is how we decorate time. -attribution

13 CHAPEL HILL

Off-limits to camping, Chapel Hill offers a tranquil ambience and a place to relax, reflect, and share time and space. This cherished and sacred area often hosts Ballad Tree Song Sharing, worship services, weddings, memorials, and can be quite the happening place at sunrise.
